

This heavily forested and sparsely populated Himalayan kingdom truly rates as the last Shangri-La. Bordered to the north by Tibet and south by India, the terrain ranges from some of the highest snowcapped mountains in the world to lush subtropical jungles-the altitude difference is nearly 24,000 feet. By national law, three quarters of the country is under forest cover. To protect this living Eden, Bhutan is approaching modernization and tourism cautiously, allowing access to less than 23,000 foreign visitors in 2007. Join award-winning photographer and Bhutan specialist Robin Smillie on one of two unique itineraries that has participants traveling in cars, not a bus, with each traveler assigned a personal Bhutanese "fixer."

#### Wyoming: Mountain Man Country Year-Round

The Upper Green River Valley has long been a favorite destination for fall travelers, but today's adventurers come packing canseras, not beaver traps. Early fur trappers valued the pristine streams and mountains for their wealth of wildlife. much as the outdoor photographer does now. Willow-lined rivers and creeks in the Wyoming and Wind River Ranges are home to moose and deer, while the high plains provide a home to pronghorn and sage grouse. Elk, bear and bighorn sheep range high up in the hills this time of year, but can be spotted by the early riser. With aspen slopes turning to gold and crisp mornings often showing the

first dusting of snow on the mountains, is a picture-perfect time to visit untain Man Country.
